

## **BRIAN DICKSON MEMORIAL AT-HOME DAD CONVENTION SCHOLARSHIP**

### Purpose:

To assist an at-home dad(s) attend the annual At-Home Dad's Convention who would otherwise be unable to attend without some financial assistance.

### Administration of Scholarship:

This Scholarship will be administered by a Scholarship Committee appointed by and serving for such term and under such conditions as may be designated by Daddyshome, Inc. Board of Directors. The terms and conditions of this Scholarship may be amended by the Board of Directors at any time without prior notice.

### Eligibility Requirements of Scholarship Candidate:

To be eligible for the scholarship a candidate must be nominated by a friend, family member, another at-home dad or At-Home Dad Group. Nominations must be submitted to the Convention Scholarship Committee at [scholarship@daddyshome.org](mailto:scholarship@daddyshome.org) or Daddyshome, Inc., 8911 Fort Hunt Rd., Alexandria, VA 22308-2635 **no later than August 15.**

The committee asks that honest and good judgment be used in nominating an at-home dad and trusts that the person or group will only nominate an at-home dad who would require financial assistance to attend the convention.

No person may receive funds from the scholarship more frequently than once every three years.

### The Selection Process:

Within five days of said deadline, or in such other manner as may, from time to time, be designated by the Board of Directors of Daddyshome, Inc., a Board Member of Daddyshome, Inc. will select the recipient(s). The recipient's name(s) will remain anonymous unless he chooses otherwise.

### Scholarship Expenditures:

The scholarship will only cover the registration fee. Travel expenses (airfare or gas), group dinners, and hotel expenses may also be covered if money is available in the scholarship fund (see below). The recipient(s) will be responsible for any other expenses he incurs.

The amount of the scholarship money available each year will be based on the lesser of (a) the past 3 year average annual income received (with income being defined as additions to corpus, including interest and amounts donated) or (b) 20% of the total funds on hand.

If any additional money is available, the committee will draw a second name. This at-home dad will receive the remainder of the funds to cover whatever costs the balance will allow for the registration fee, travel expenses, group dinner and/or hotel.

Recipient(s) Responsibilities:

The registration fee will be paid directly by Daddyshome, Inc.

If the Scholarship includes payment of travel expenses, the recipient(s) must submit receipts for the purchase of his airline ticket or gas before receiving payment of the scholarship. A reimbursement check for these travel expenses will be issued to the recipient(s) upon arrival at the convention. If the Scholarship includes payment of the group dinner and/or hotel, those will be paid directly by Daddyshome.
